# **Program Overview**

Reading.com is a fun, co-play experience designed for a grownup to teach a child to read. With scripted phonics lessons and an engaging, easy-to-follow progression, we will guide you in becoming your child's best reading teacher... no special training needed!

As your child begins our program, they will develop their letter and letter-sound recognition as well as phonemic awareness. With a strong foundation in letter and sound knowledge, your child will begin learning to decode through letter blending and high-frequency word recognition, and very soon they will be applying those skills to reading books.

As you and your child progress through lessons, you'll notice that skills taught in our program aren't isolated, but rather practiced and reviewed throughout. The key components of our lessons are an introduction and practice with a new skill, application of that skill through reading words & books, and reinforcement of that skill through games. Lessons only take about 20 minutes to complete, and if you and your child complete 3-5 lessons a week, your child will unlock their first book in just a few weeks!

Books are initially introduced in a co-read format to better ease your child into reading in a supportive way. This means that you will read some of the text and your child will have other text designated just for them. You'll notice that book illustrations are hidden until after your child reads the words on a page; this is intentional to prevent unhelpful habits like guessing and cueing. All the books your child has unlocked will be stored in their Reading.com library for them to access and reread as they like.

As your child completes lessons, they will notice that game levels and printable activities unlock throughout. Games and activities can be played independently or with adult support. Remember to revisit games often to help your child strengthen the new skills they've learned.



# **Lesson Breakdown**

## Lesson 1-10

They will develop phonemic awareness and learn enough letters and phonemes to begin letter blending and word reading with simple CVC words. In lesson 10, your child will read their first book, which will be in a co-read format. After reading this book, you will check for your child's understanding with comprehension questions.
